The Kingdom Hoped For...

Isaiah 52:7-10 (NLT), **7** How beautiful on the mountain are the feet of the messenger who brings good news, **the good news of peace and salvation.** The news that the **God of Israel reigns.** **8** The watchmen shouts and sings with joy. Before their very eyes they see the Lord returning to Jerusalem. **9** Let the ruins of Jerusalem break into joyful song for the Lord has comforted his people. He has redeemed Jerusalem. **10** The Lord has demonstrated his holy power before the eyes of all the nations. All the ends of the earth will see the victory of our God.

Isaiah 61:1-3 (NLT), **1** The Spirit of the sovereign Lord is upon me, for the Lord has anointed me to bring **good news to the poor.** He sent me to **comfort the brokenhearted, proclaim that the captives will be released and the prisoners will be freed.** **2** He sent me to tell those who mourn that **the time of the Lord’s favor has come** and with it the day of God’s anger against his enemies. **3** To all who mourn in Israel, he will give a crown of beauty for ashes and joyous blessing instead of mourning. Festive praise instead of despair. In their righteousness they’ll be like great oaks that the Lord has planted for his own glory.

Mark 8:34-37 (NLT), **34** Then calling the crowd to join his disciples, he said, ‘If any of you want to be my follower you must turn from your selfish ways, pick up your cross and follow me. **35** If you try to hang on to your life you’ll lose it. **36** But if you give up your life for my sake and for the sake of the good news, you will save it. **What do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your soul? 37** Is anything worth more than your soul?’
